*Do the HW **before** the session. Always start with the Short, then move to the Tall, and, if you are the Rambo of LSAT prep, do the Grande at the end.*

When we assign a chapter, look in your strategy guides. When we note a "practice set," look in your Manhattan LSAT Practice Book, or, if it ends with "(NEXT)", in The Next 10 Actual, Official LSAT PrepTests. Labs can be found in the lab section of your student center.

Games that are in quotes -- like "Seven Boats" -- can be found online in the logic game archive. These are pretty tough games our teachers have written. Go to www.manhattanlsat.com/logic-games-practice.cfm or you can find the link in your student center.

To find explanations for anything – a game, an LR question, an RC passage, something in the strategy guides – go to our forums – www.manhattanlsat.com/forums. "LR" = logical reasoning

"PT" = PrepTest

"LG" = logic games

"S" = section in that PrepTest

"RC" = reading comprehension

"G" = game
